Learn the tools, skills, and techniques to start quilting! Create a simple baby or lap quilt while building confidence with your sewing machine and quilting tools.

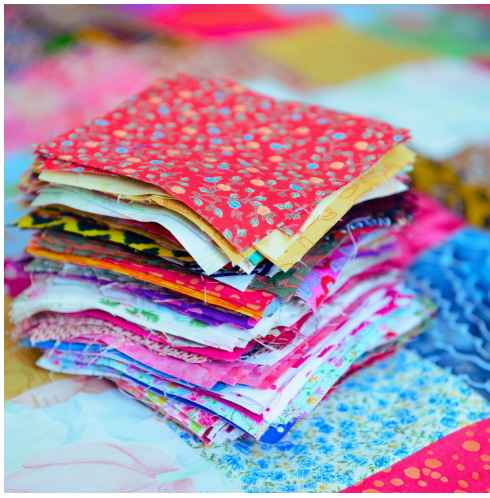
Monthly meetings, with “homework” between sessions to keep you sewing.

Beginning Basic Quilting Group

Join us to explore the basics of quilting in a fun, beginner-friendly setting! In the first session, we'll cover sewing machine care and maintenance, threading, bobbin winding, tension adjustments, and using quilting tools like rotary cutters and rulers. At the second session, we'll begin piecing a simple baby or lap quilt top.



You'll learn:

- How to use essential quilting tools
- Machine basics (threading, bobbin, needles, seam allowance)
- Tips for straight seams and quilt piecing


What to bring: A sewing machine in good working order (with cord, foot pedal, and manual if available), sewing feet/needles, plus pins and small scissors if you have them.
